



International Cadet Class 2020 Australian Championship

Notice of Race – Amendment 1

The following clauses have been amended:

4. Fees

- 4.1 The required fees are as follows: \$AU380 per boat including the ICCA capitation fee. This includes tickets to the opening and closing ceremonies for the helm and crew.
- 4.2 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority for an additional fee of \$AU100 per boat.
- 4.3 The entry fee for coach boats and support boats is \$AU150 and must be paid at registration.
- 4.4 In the event that the championship is cancelled due to Covid-19 restrictions enforced by the Australian and/or State Governments, entry fees will be refunded in full.

5.3 It is intended that racing will be conducted during afternoon sessions with a warning signal at approximately 1325. If the schedule needs to be revised during the event, due to adverse weather or other factors, morning sessions with a warning signal of 0955 may be used.

5.4 There shall be a maximum of three races sailed per session.

5.5 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1530.

11. Scoring

11.1 Twelve (12) races are scheduled of which five (5) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2 When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11.3 When from six (6) to nine (9) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11.4 When from ten (10) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two (2) worst scores.

15. Qualification for Further Events

15.1 The top seven (7) boats from the 2020 International Cadet Australian Championship (Williamstown) will be invited to compete as part of the Australian team at the 2021 World Championship (date and venue TBC).
